 Screen in green polycarbonate covered with a gold layer. 500 x 250 x 1 mm (E9211-112). Sewed with para-aramid threads on an aluminized fabric to increase the surface of protection. The support and the gold layer filter the infrared and the UV – the gold layer on the extern side is covered of a varnish which brings a better mechanical resistance to scratchResistance to radiant heat up to 135°C continually. Adjustable visor on helmet by the universal liftable mount system ref 9100 and the headgear E9020 equip the 1000-722 outfit – the "AUGENSEIT" mark means side towards the eye
